When to keep your child home from school

(In compliance with the Burlington County Health Department)

- Temperature > 100.4
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Congestion, runny nose
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell

Calling out a student for the day (notify nurses office before the start of the school day)

Extra Clothes

- Please keep an extra pair of clothes in your child's backpack (shirt, pants, socks, undies) in a bag.

- If your child needs to take any medication at school, please get a medication form from the health office for you and your doctor to fill out.
